

Maejo University Announcement Entrance Examination Results for Doctoral Degree Study Academic Year 2025, Session 3

According to Maejo University entrance examination results for Doctoral Degree Study for the 2nd Semester of the Academic Year 2025, the list of candidates who have passed the examination for admission is attached. They are required to take the following actions.

1. Registration as a new student (Online)

The prospective students who have already passed the entrance examination are required to complete online self-report on the website: admissions.mju.ac.th/graduate/en, by October 30, 2025.

2. Tuition fee payment

The students must pay the tuition fee through the website: admissions.mju.ac.th/graduate During the period from October 30, 2025 to November 3, 2025 as follows:

2.1 Thai students

- 1) Login >> at admissions.mju.ac.th/graduate.
- 2) Select the menu to **Check Apply Status**. >> Fill in ID card number and phone number. >> Select Authentication.
- 3) Select the "Pay" button. The tuition fee can be paid through 2 channels as follows:

<u>Channel 1</u>: Scan QR Code to pay tuition fees via Mobile Banking Application of any bank (no service charge).

<u>Channel 2</u>: Pay your tuition fee with credit cards. (There is a fee for using the service at the rate specified by the credit card provider):

- American Express
- VISA/Master Card

2.2 Foreign students

- 1) Login >> at admissions.mju.ac.th/graduate/en.
- 2) Select the menu Check Apply Status >> Fill in your Passport No. >> Press Sign in.
- 3) Select the "Pay" button. You can pay the tuition fee through 3 channels as follows:

<u>Channel 1</u>: Scan QR Code to pay tuition fee via Mobile Banking Application of any bank (no service charge)

<u>Channel 2</u>: Pay with credit cards. (There is a fee for using the service at the rate specified by the credit card provider):

- American Express
- VISA/Master Card

<u>Channel 3</u>: Pay through E-wallet payment:

- Alipay
- WeChat
- Note: 1. The students who have passed the selection examination can check the status of tuition payment on the next day at 10:00 a.m. onwards (not including public holidays).
- 2. Tuition fee, once paid, cannot be refunded under any circumstances, except for payment exceeding the rate set by the university.

3. Reporting for registration as new students (via online system)

3.1 Schedule for reporting for registration as new students

The students who have passed the entrance examination and have already paid their tuition fee should report online to register as new students at the website: admissions.mju.ac.th/graduate/en during the period from October 30, 2025 to November 3, 2025.

3.2 Documents for registration online as new students

Thai Students

- 1) A copy of Master's degree transcript in the case of the prospective students who have already passed the entrance examination but have not submitted graduation documents with the application form.
- 2) A copy of a degree certificate or a letter of degree approval issued by the university council of his/her former university.

If a prospective student has not finished his/her Master's degree before the date of student registration, the university will tentatively accept his/her self-reporting. However, he/she must finish his/her Master's courses while waiting for the degree approval before Monday, November 17, 2025 (before the opening of the 2nd semester of the Academic Year 2025).

- 3) A copy of English language test result as per the university regulation for passing a foreign language test (for doctoral degree students).
 - 4) A copy of name / surname/rank change or marriage certificate (if applicable).
- 5) A letter of permission to study signed by a superior of a Director-General or equivalent position (for those prospective students who are government officials, university staff or state enterprise employees and who enroll in a regular program). If the aforementioned letter is not submitted, the university reserves its right not to accept the self-report.
 - 6) A letter of consent to disclose the information to the third party.

Foreign Students

- 1) A copy of Master's degree transcript certified by the Embassy or a certificate of qualification from an institution accredited by the Ministry of Education of the student's country, or certified by the Civil Service Commission (CSC) to be confirmed by Maejo University. If such document cannot be provided on the registration day, it can be submitted later, but no later than one semester.
- 2) A copy of degree certificate or a letter of degree approval issued by the university council of his/her former university certified by the Embassy.
- 3) A copy of English language test result as per to the university regulation for passing a foreign language test (for doctoral degree students).
 - 4) A copy of name / surname change or marriage certificate (if applicable).
 - 5) A Letter of consent to disclose the information to the third party.
- Note: 1. The prospective students must sign their names on all the copies to certify them.
- 2. If it turns out later that any prospective student who has passed the entrance examination lacks any of the qualifications or that the registration documents are false or counterfeit, his/her eligibility for reporting for student registration will be revoked, even though he/she may have already reported to be registered as a new student or his/her tuition fee may have been paid. He/she might also be legally prosecuted.

3.3 Uploading online self-report documents

The prospective students who have already passed the entrance examination are required to upload online self-report documents according to Section 3.2 in PDF file format on the website: admissions.mju.ac.th/graduate, during the period from October 30, 2025 to November 9, 2025, according to the details below. (If the documents are not submitted or incomplete, the applicants will be considered as waiving their rights in reporting and registering as students.)

Step 1: Make copies of the documents for self-reporting, separated into items according to Section 3.2.

Step 2: Sign to certify every page and cross with the phrase "Used for reporting to study at the graduate level, Maejo University only".

Step 3: Scan as a PDF file format. Page size is A4 (according to the size of the document). The file size must not exceed 2 MB (in the case of 2 pages, scan both the front and back pages into one file and upload).

Note: New students must check for the uploaded document status at admissions.mju.ac.th/graduate >> Check Apply Status >> Enter your Passport No. >> Check the list of uploaded documents. If the document is incorrect or additional documents are required to be submitted, there will be a warning message in the reporting system. Those who pass the selection must complete the corrections by November 9, 2025 at 4:00 p.m. (local time). If the file is not corrected or uploaded within the specified period of time, the university will not issue a student ID under any circumstances.

4. Orientation for new students

4.1 Thai Students

November 13, 2025 at 08.45 - 12.00 a.m. (local time) via online system: Zoom Meeting program. The university will inform students of the link via e-mail.

4.2 Foreign Students

November 13, 2025 at 01.30 - 03.00 p.m. (local time) via online system : Zoom Meeting program. The university will inform students of the link via e-mail.

5. Orientation for each field of study

The respective Department will inform the students later.

6. Opening of the semester and class meeting

The university's first semester of the 2025 academic year is scheduled on Monday, November 17, 2025. (In the first semester of study, the university will process course registration for all new students.)

- Date of checking registration results: November 7, 2025 onwards
