

Maejo University Announcement Entrance Examination Results for Doctoral's Degree Study Academic Year 2025, Session 2

According to Maejo University entrance examination procedure for Doctoral's Degree Study for the 1st Semester of the Academic Year 2025, Session 2, the list of candidates who have passed the entrance examination for admission is attached. They are required to take the following actions.

1. Registration as a new student (Online)

The prospective students who have already passed the entrance examination are required to complete online self-report on the website: admissions.mju.ac.th/graduate/en, by June 12, 2025.

2. Tuition fees payment

The students must pay the tuition fee through the website: admissions.mju.ac.th/graduate **During June 10 - 12, 2025** as follows:

2.1 Thai students

- 1) Login >> at admissions.mju.ac.th/graduate
- 2) Select the menu to **Check Apply Status**. >> Fill in ID card number and phone number. >> Select Authentication
- 3) Select the "Pay" button. The tuition fees could for paid through 2 channels as follows:

<u>Channel 1</u>: Scan QR Code to pay tuition fees via Mobile Banking Application of any bank (no service charge)

<u>Channel 2</u>: Pay your tuition fees with Credit Cards. (There is a fee for using the service at the rate specified by the credit card provider)

- VISA/Master Card

2.2 Foreign students

- 1) Login >> at admissions.mju.ac.th/graduate/en
- 2) Select the menu Check Apply Status >> Fill in your Passport No. >> Press Sign in.
- 3) Select the "Pay" button. You can pay the tuition fees through 3 channels as follows:

<u>Channel 1</u>: Scan QR Code to pay tuition fees via Mobile Banking Application of any bank (no service charge)

<u>Channel 2</u>: Pay with Credit Cards. (There is a fee for using the service at the rate specified by the credit card provider)

- VISA/Master Card

<u>Channel 3</u>: Pay through E-wallet payment.

- Alipay
- WeChat

Note: 1. The students who have passed the selection examination can cheek the status of tuition payment on the next day at 10:00 a.m. onwards (not in cluding public holidays)

- 2. Tuition fees, once paid, cannot be refunded under any circumstances, except for payment more than the rate set by the university
- 3. Reporting for registration as new students (via online system)

3.1 Schedule for reporting for registration as new students

The students who have passed the entrance examination and have already paid their tuition fees. Should report online to register as new students at the website: admissions.mju.ac.th/graduate/en during June 10 - 16, 2025.

3.2 Documents for registration online as new students

Thai Students

- 1) One copy of Master's degree transcript, in case of the prospective students who have already passed the entrance examination but have not submitted graduation documents with the application form.
- 2) One copy of the degree certificate or a letter of degree approval issued by the university council of his/her previous university.

If a prospective student has not finished his/her Master's degree before the date of student registration, the university will accept his/her self-reporting, however, he/she has to finish his/her Master's courses and is waiting for the degree approval before Monday, June 23, 2025 (before the opening of the 1st semester of the Academic Year 2025)

- 3) One copy of English language test result according to the university regulation on the criteria for passing a foreign language test (for doctoral degree students).
 - 4) One copy of name / surname/rank change or marriage certificate (if applicable).
- 5) A letter of permission to study signed by a superior at a Director-General or equivalent position (for those prospective students who are government officials, university staff or state enterprise employees and enroll in a regular program). If the aforementioned letter is not submitted, the university reserves its right not to accept the self-report.
 - 6) One Letter of consent to disclose the information to the third party.

Foreign Students

- 1) One copy of Master's degree transcripts certified by the Embassy, , or a certificate of qualification from an institution accredited by the Ministry of Education of the students country, or certified by the Civil Service Commission (CSC) to be done by Maejo University, If such document cannot be provided on the registration day, it can be submitted later, but no later than one semester.
- 2) One copy of a degree certificate or a letter of degree approval issued by the university council of his/her former university certified by the Embassy.
- 3) One copy of English language test result according to the university regulation on the criteria for passing a foreign language test (for doctoral degree students).
 - 4) One copy of name / surname change or marriage certificate (if applicable).
 - 5) One Letter of consent to disclose the information to the third party.
- Note: 1. The prospective students must sign their names on all the copies to certify that they are true copies.
- 2. If it appears later that any prospective students who have passed the entrance examination lack any of the qualifications or It was later revealed that the registration documents are false or counterfeited, they will have their right to report for student registration revoked, even though they have already reported themselves to be registered as new students or their tuition fees have been paid. They may be legally prosecuted.

3.3 Uploading online self-report documents

The prospective students who have already passed the entrance examination are required to upload online self-report documents according to Section 3.2 in PDF file format on the website admissions.mju.ac.th/graduate, during, June 10 - 16, 2025, according to the following details. (If the documents are not submitted or incompleted, the applicants will be considered as having waived their rights in reporting and registering as students)

Step 1 : Make copies of the documents for self-reporting, separated into items according to Section 3.2

Step 2: Sign to certify that they are true copies and crossed with the message "Used for reporting to study at the graduate level, Maejo University only" (in the case of having 2 pages, both sides must be signed to certify as true copies.)

Step 3: Scan as a PDF file format. Page size is A4 (according to the size of the document). The file size does not exceed 2 MB (in the case of 2 pages, scan both the front and back pages into one file and upload).

Note: New students must check the uploaded document status at admissions.mju.ac.th/graduate >> Check Apply Status >> Enter your Passport No. >> Check the list of uploaded documents. If the document is incorrect or additional documents are required to be submitted, there will be a warning message in the reporting system. Those who pass the selection must complete the corrections by June 16, 2025 at 4:00 p.m. (Time in Thailand) If the file is not corrected or uploaded within the specified period of time, the university will not issue a student ID under any circumstances.

4. Orientation for new students

5. Orientation for each field of study

The respective Department will inform the students later.

6. Teaching and learning management and the opening of the semester

The university plans to open the first semester of the 2025 academic year on Monday, June 23, 2025 (in the first semester of study The university will process course registration for all new students.)
