Specific Qualifications:

Plan 1.1 Academic

- 1) Applicants must hold at least a Bachelor's degree in Engineering, Food Science or Technology, Agricultural Mechanization, or related Applied Sciences from an institution accredited by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), with a minimum cumulative GPA (GPAX) of 3.00.
- 2) Applicants meeting the educational backgrounds in Item 1 with a GPAX of at least 2.75 must have at least one (1) research publication in a recognized national journal.
- 3) Applicants must meet all qualifications stipulated by Maejo University Regulations on Graduate Education.
- 4) Other cases shall be subject to the discretion of the Student Admissions Committee.

Plan 1.2 Academic

- 1) Applicants must hold at least a Bachelor's degree in Engineering, Food Science or Technology, Agricultural Mechanization, or related Applied Sciences from an institution accredited by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), with a minimum cumulative GPA (GPAX) of 2.50. Alternatively, admission may be granted based on the discretion of the Program Chair or the Program Committee.
- 2) Applicants must meet all qualifications stipulated by Maejo University Regulations on Graduate Education.
- 3) Other cases shall be subject to the discretion of the Student Admissions Committee.

Plan 2 Professional

- 1) Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or equivalent in Science and Technology with a minimum cumulative GPA (GPAX) of 2.25. Additionally, applicants must have at least one (1) year of work experience in the food industry or possess qualifications deemed appropriate by the Program Chair or Program Committee.
- 2) Applicants must meet all qualifications stipulated by Maejo University Regulations on Graduate Education.
- 3) Other cases shall be subject to the discretion of the Student Admissions Committee.

Required Application Documents:

- A digital file of a straight-face photograph, size 1 inch (300 x 400 pixels), without a hat or dark glasses, taken within the last 6 months; graduation gown photos are not permitted (to be uploaded to the application system).
- A copy of the passport (only the first page with personal information).
- A copy of the undergraduate transcript.
- A certificate of student status for those in the final semester of their undergraduate program.
- A copy of the document showing name/surname change, or marriage certificate (in case the name/surname does not match other application documents).
- Research/Thesis Title with Research Approach.

Note: Applicants are required to upload all supporting documents as specified by the University and the Program into the admission system within the application period of each round.
