Specific Qualifications:

• Plan 1.1 Academic (Thesis only)

Applicants must have completed a bachelor's degree or its equivalent in science or social science from an educational institution accredited by the Office of the Higher Education Commission (OHEC) or the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC). In addition, applicants must have either published research work or have at least three years of professional experience in forestry, natural resources and environment, or a related field. Consideration of eligibility is subject to the discretion of the program coordinator.

Plan 1.2 Academic (Coursework and Thesis)

Applicants must have completed a bachelor's degree or its equivalent in science or social science from an educational institution accredited by the Office of the Higher Education Commission (OHEC) or the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC).

Required Application Documents:

- A digital file of a straight-face photograph, size 1 inch (300 x 400 pixels), without a hat or dark glasses, taken within the last 6 months; graduation gown photos are not permitted (to be uploaded to the application system).
- A copy of the passport (only the first page with personal information).
- A copy of the undergraduate transcript.
- A copy of the document showing name/surname change, or marriage certificate (in case the name/surname does not match other application documents).
- A certificate of student status for those in the final semester of their undergraduate program.
