Plan 1.1 Academic

- 1) Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or its equivalent in any scientific field from an institution accredited by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of no less than 3.25; or
- 2) Applicants who have graduated as specified in item 1 but with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of no less than 2.75 throughout the program, or have at least one year of experience in agricultural extension and rural development, or other related agricultural fields;
- 3) Must possess qualifications as specified in the regulations of Maejo University regarding graduate studies, as well as other relevant university regulations and announcements in effect at the time:
 - 4) Other cases shall be at the discretion of the student selection committee.

Plan 1.2 Academic

- 1) Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or its equivalent in any scientific field from an institution accredited by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of no less than 2.50; or
- 2) Applicants who have graduated as specified in item 1, but with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) throughout the program of less than 2.50, must meet additional qualifications as determined appropriate by the program advisor or program committee; or
- 3) In the case that applicants have not graduated with a Bachelor's degree in the major they wish to pursue and/or do not have the required experience as stipulated, their application may be considered if the committee deems that the applicant has sufficient potential to pursue studies in the chosen major;
- 4) Must possess qualifications as specified in the regulations of Maejo University regarding graduate studies, as well as other relevant university regulations and announcements in effect at the time;
 - 5) Other cases shall be at the discretion of the student selection committee.

Plan 2 Professional

- 1) Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree or its equivalent in any scientific field from an institution accredited by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of no less than 2.50; or
- 2) Applicants who have graduated as specified in item 1, but with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of less than 2.50 throughout the program, must meet additional qualifications as determined appropriate by the program advisor or program committee; or
- 3) In cases where applicants have not graduated with a bachelor's degree in the major they wish to pursue and/or do not have the required experience as specified, admission may be considered if the committee believes the applicant has sufficient potential to study in the chosen major;
- 4) Must possess qualifications as specified in the regulations of Maejo University regarding graduate studies, as well as other relevant university regulations and announcements in effect at the time;
 - 5) Other cases shall be at the discretion of the student selection committee.

Required Application Documents:

- A digital file of a straight-face photograph, size 1 inch (300 x 400 pixels), without a hat or dark glasses, taken within the last 6 months; graduation gown photos are not permitted (to be uploaded to the application system).
- A recommendation letter, in the format provided by the Admissions and Public Relations Division, duly filled and signed by a supervisor, a former instructor, or an individual who knows the applicant well (excluding family members).
- A copy of the passport (only the first page with personal information).
- A copy of the undergraduate transcript.
- A copy of the transcript of records at the Higher Vocational Certificate (High Vocational Diploma) level, or an equivalent Associate Degree.
- A certificate of student status for those in the final semester of their undergraduate program.
- A copy of the document showing name/surname change, or marriage certificate (in case the name/surname does not match other application documents).
