Specific Qualifications:

Plan A Type A (1)

- 1) Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree in agriculture, in Animal Husbandry, Animal Science, or an equivalent field from an institution accredited by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of not less than 3.25 throughout the program; or
- 2) Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree in science, agriculture, or a related or equivalent field from an institution accredited by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of not less than 3.25 throughout the program. Additional prerequisite courses may be required as specified by the program coordinator.
- 3) Applicants who satisfy the requirements in (1) or (2) but have a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of not less than 2.75 must have a published research work and/or at least one year of practical experience in animal science. A research proposal expected to be developed into a thesis should be submitted along with the application.
- 4) Applicants must meet the qualifications specified in the Maejo University Regulations on Graduate Studies and other relevant rules and announcements in effect at the time.
 - 5) Other cases are subject to the discretion of the student selection committee.

Plan A Type A (2)

1) Applicants must have completed a bachelor's degree in agriculture, in Animal Husbandry, Animal Science, or an equivalent field from an institution accredited by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of not less than 2.50 throughout the program; or

2) Applicants must have completed a bachelor's degree in science, agriculture, or other related or equivalent fields from an institution accredited by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), with a cumulative grade point average (GPAX) of not less than 2.50 throughout the program. Additional prerequisite courses may be required as specified by the program coordinator.

3) Applicants must meet the qualifications specified in the Maejo University Regulations on Graduate Studies and other relevant rules and announcements in effect at the time.

In cases where applicants do not fully meet any particular qualification, consideration shall be at the discretion of the student selection committee.

Required Application Documents:

- A digital file of a straight-face photograph, size 1 inch (300 x 400 pixels), without a hat or dark glasses, taken within the last 6 months; graduation gown photos are not permitted (to be uploaded to the application system).
- A recommendation letter, in the format provided by the Admissions and Public Relations Division, duly filled and signed by a supervisor, a former instructor, or an individual who knows the applicant well (excluding family members).
- A copy of the passport (only the first page with personal information).
- A copy of the undergraduate transcript.
- A certificate of student status for those in the final semester of their undergraduate program.
- A copy of the document showing name/surname change, or marriage certificate (in case the name/surname does not match other application documents).
