#### Specific Qualifications:

##### Plan 1.1

1) Applicants must hold a Master's degree or equivalent in any field or related disciplines from an accredited institution recognized by the Office of the Permanent Secretary for Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation (MHESI) or the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.50

2) Applicants who meet the requirements in item 1 but have a cumulative GPA lower than 3.50 must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Have at least one research publication in a recognized journal.
- Have at least one year of professional experience in resource management, development, or other related fields.

3) Applicants must possess all qualifications in accordance with Maejo University's Regulations on Graduate Education and any other relevant university announcements or regulations currently in effect.

4) For International Applicants: Applicants must provide educational credentials or certificates of degree equivalency from a government-recognized institution in their home country, or an accredited degree validation agency, or a certification from the respective Embassy.

##### Plan 2.1

1) Applicants must hold a Master's degree or equivalent in any field or related disciplines from an accredited institution recognized by the Office of the Permanent Secretary for Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation (MHESI) or the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.50.

2) Applicants who meet the requirements in item 1 but have a cumulative GPA lower than 3.50 must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Have at least one research publication in a recognized journal.
- Have at least one year of professional experience in resource management, development, or other related fields.

3) Applicants must possess all qualifications in accordance with Maejo University's Regulations on Graduate Education and any other relevant university announcements or regulations currently in effect.

4) For International Applicants: Applicants must provide educational credentials or certificates of degree equivalency from a government-recognized institution in their home country, an accredited degree validation agency, or a certification from the respective Embassy.

5) Successful candidates enrolling in the Regular Program who are government officials, university employees, or state enterprise employees must submit an Official Study Leave Approval Letter from their Department Head or an equivalent authority (signed by the Director-General or an equivalent position).

6) Other cases are subject to the discretion of the Entrance Examination Committee.

#### **Required Application Documents:**

- A digital file of a straight-face photograph, size 1 inch (300 x 400 pixels), without a hat or dark glasses, taken within the last 6 months; graduation gown photos are not permitted (to be uploaded to the application system).
- A recommendation letter, in the format provided by the Admissions and Public Relations Division, duly filled and signed by a supervisor, a former instructor, or an individual who knows the applicant well (excluding family members).
- A copy of the passport (only the first page with personal information).
- A copy of the Master's degree academic transcript.
- A copy of the undergraduate transcript.
- A copy of the document showing name/surname change, or marriage certificate (in case the name/surname does not match other application documents).
- A certificate of student status for those in the final semester of their undergraduate program.
