Specific Qualifications:

Applicants must have graduated from an institution accredited by the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC) and meet all the qualifications specified in the Maejo University Regulations on Graduate Studies as well as the annual announcements regarding admissions. Additional qualifications are as follows:

- 1) Possess an English proficiency test score as specified by the university; and
- 2) For Plan 1, the program emphasizes doctoral dissertation research.

Plan 1.1: For graduates with a Master's degree in agriculture or a related field, who have research experience demonstrated by presenting research (oral presentation) at an academic conference with proceedings, or by publishing research in a recognized academic journal, within five years prior to enrollment. Admission is subject to the discretion of the program committee.

- 3) Plan 2: Emphasizes coursework and research skills in the dissertation.
- **Plan 2.1:** For graduates with a Master's degree in agriculture or a related field who have a minimum GPA of 3.00. Admission is subject to the discretion of the program committee.

Plan 2.2: For graduates with a Bachelor's degree in agriculture or a related field who have excellent academic performance (with a minimum GPA of 3.25 or second-class honors and above) and research experience. Admission is subject to the discretion of the program committee.

Required Application Documents:

- A digital file of a straight-face photograph, size 1 inch (300 x 400 pixels), without a hat or dark glasses, taken within the last 6 months; graduation gown photos are not permitted (to be uploaded to the application system).
- A recommendation letter, in the format provided by the Admissions and Public Relations Division, duly filled and signed by a supervisor, a former instructor, or an individual who knows the applicant well (excluding family members).
- A copy of the passport (only the first page with personal information).
- A copy of the Master's Degree Academic Transcript
- A certificate of student status for those in the final semester of their Master's Degree Program
- A copy of the document showing name/surname change, or marriage certificate

(in case the name/surname does not match other application documents).
