Note for Applicants:

Applicants for Plan 2.1 (Special Program) in the first semester of the 2026 academic year should be aware that instruction for this program will officially commence in the second semester of the 2026 academic year.

Specific Qualifications:

1) Applicants must hold a Master's degree or equivalent in Agriculture, Agricultural Extension, Community Resource Management, Community Development, Education, Environmental Management, Social Sciences, Administration, Agricultural Economics, or other related fields from an accredited institution recognized by the Office of the Permanent Secretary for Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation (MHESI) or the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC), with a minimum cumulative GPA (GPAX) of 3.50.

2) Applicants who meet the requirements in item 1 but have a cumulative GPA (GPAX) lower than 3.50 may be considered for admission at the discretion of the Entrance Examination Committee.

3) Applicants must possess all qualifications in accordance with Maejo University's Regulations on Graduate Education and any other relevant university announcements or regulations in effect at the time of application.

4) Other cases are subject to the discretion of the Entrance Examination Committee.

Required Application Documents:

- A digital file of a straight-face photograph, size 1 inch (300 x 400 pixels), without a hat or dark glasses, taken within the last 6 months; graduation gown photos are not permitted (to be uploaded to the application system).
- A copy of the passport (only the first page with personal information).
- A copy of the Master's degree academic transcript.
- A copy of the document showing name/surname change, or marriage certificate (in case the name/surname does not match other application documents).
- A certificate of student status for those in the final semester of their undergraduate program.
