Specific Program Qualifications

1) Applicants must possess qualifications in accordance with the relevant regulations of Maejo University regarding graduate studies in effect at the time of application, as well as other applicable university rules and regulations as appropriate.

2) Applicants must have graduated with a Master's degree in any field of Engineering, Science, or Food Science and Technology, related applied sciences, or as approved by the program director.

Plan 1.1 for Dual Doctoral Degree:

1) Requirements must comply with the regulations mutually agreed upon between the universities, as stipulated in the latest version of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA).

2) Other cases shall be at the discretion of the joint student selection committee of both institutions.

- A copy of the document showing name/surname change, or marriage certificate (in case the name/surname does not match other application documents).
