**Plan 1.1 and Plan 2.1**

For those who have completed a master's degree or equivalent in fields related to architectural and art design, including design in the areas of industrial, environmental science, science and technology, or other related fields from an institution accredited by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation (MHESI) or the Office of the Civil Service Commission (OCSC). Applicants for Study Plan 1.1 must have a cumulative GPA of not less than 3.50 throughout the program, or have at least one research publication in an academic journal according to the criteria set by the OCSC, or have at least one year of work experience in design innovation or other related fields, or have a design work that has been granted a petty patent or patent.

**Note:** Foreign applicants who wish to enroll must obtain approval from the program director prior to admission.

**Required Application Documents:**

- A digital file of a straight-face photograph, size 1 inch (300 x 400 pixels), without a hat or dark glasses, taken within the last 6 months; graduation gown photos are not permitted (to be uploaded to the application system).
- A copy of the passport (only the first page with personal information).
- A copy of the Master's Degree Academic Transcript
- A certificate of student status for those in the final semester of their Master's Degree Program
- A copy of the document showing name/surname change, or marriage certificate (in case the name/surname does not match other application documents).

Supporting documents for the application should be submitted on the interview day.

Applicants are required to submit additional documents, including a proposed research topic and scope as part of the application process, as follows:

- 1) The research topic of interest
- 2) The background and significance of the research
- 3) The expected outcomes of the research
- 4) The research implementation plan
